

Program Specific Requirements

PHARMACY TECHNICIAN PROGRAM

Grade 12 graduation or equivalent

Grade 12 English with a minimum grade of 50% (MB graduates- G12 Core English: Comprehensive Focus, Literary Focus or Transactional Focus)

Grade 12 Math (Pre-calculus/Applied Math 40S or equivalent) with a 50% or higher

Grade 12 Chemistry (Chemistry 40S or equivalent) with a 50% or higher

Grade 12 Biology (Biology 40S or equivalent) with 50% or higher

Applicant must write the Robertson College entrance test with a final minimum overall score of 70% and a minimum of 70% achieved in the Math, Reading & General portions of the test

Demonstrate proficiency in basic computer literacy as verified by Robertson proficiency assessment. It is encouraged that students entering this program have some knowledge of word processing and familiarity with a Windows Operating System

Keyboarding Speed of 20 WPM (verified by Robertson College keyboarding assessment)

Only the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) and International English Language Testing System (IELTS) are accepted, as per the Canadian Council for Accreditation of Pharmacy Programs. The scores required are listed below.
