

To start the refund process, please complete our Withdrawal Form.
In order for a student contract to be terminated, the following must occur:

- a. The student gives written notice of withdrawal or,
- b. The student is expelled from the program due to a violation of college policy, or
- c. The student is absent for more than 10% of the total hours of instruction within the first 2/3 of the program.

Refund is available only through the same method that students used for the payment.

2/3 after start of the program	No refund (If there is a balance due, the student is responsible for making payment arrangements)

* Non-refundable fees for the Diploma Programs are Application fee and the TCF fee

* Please note, all fees paid for the PACE program are also non-refundable

The refund calculator is based on the following:

- a. The total cost of the program
- b. The total hours of the program
- c. The total hours of instruction that the student was expected to be in attendance for, up until the date of withdrawal
- d. The non-refundable registration fee of \$225.00
- e. The non-refundable TCF fee of 1% of tuition
- f. The amount of tuition the student paid up until the date of withdrawal

Visa Rejection

Applicants who are denied a Study Permit will forfeit only the application fee. A copy of the visa rejection letter from Immigration, Refugees, and Citizenship Canada (IRCC) is required to process the deposit and tuition refunds.

* Proof of visa rejection must be submitted within 4 weeks to receive a full refund

Please note, the refund process takes up to 6 weeks from the date we receive the full withdrawal package
